- 8. Full Fibre Broadband:** Report that BT Openreach have been contracted to prepare the parish for full fibre broadband, with a completion date of 31<sup>st</sup> March 2026. It is understood that fibre will be run the closet node (telegraph pole or underground chamber) to each property. The final connection across the property boundary, from the node the individual buildings, will be done when individuals order an upgrade from their current copper-wire service.
